2.2) If you primarily attended a section that is not assigned to you, what was your primary reason for doing so?

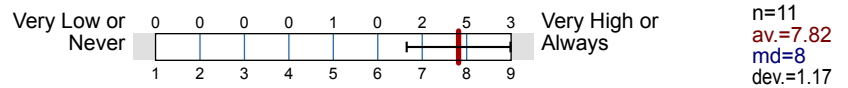

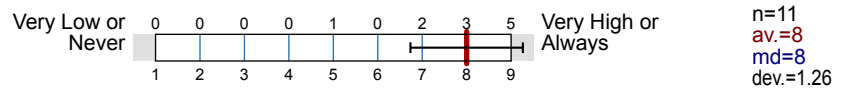

3.2) Teaching Assistant Concern - The T.A. was concerned about student learning.

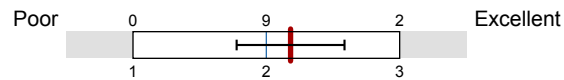

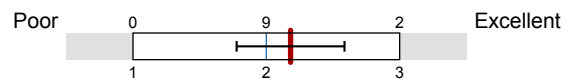

 - He really instilled confidence into us on how we could handle the class and really broke down the material well. No weaknesses
 - He was very good with the material but he sometimes included unnecessary info that would confuse me
 - I really liked this TA. He went over the examples and really made sure we were learning. He encourages questions and even took aside several minutes before discussion for general questions. One of the best Econ TAs I've had at UCLA.
 - Real strengths were his commitment to teaching. He cared about his students and it reflected in his discussions and notes. I think he has good communication skills, and is able to explain concepts quickly and effectively. One of his weaknesses I suppose would be that he can expand on concepts too much which can get confusing. This just means talking about material that is in future economic classes. But that isn't necessarily a bad thing because it can prepare us for the future and explain why we don't cover certain aspects of micro econ in this class.

 - The TA was very involved with the students in my section and cared a lot about teaching us the material and making sure we were prepared when he made mistakes it was useful to see ways where people commonly go wrong and he would always show us the correct way to do it. Even though he would sometimes go too fast, he would make sure that if anyone asked a question, that student would understand. advice which was really nice as UCLA doesn't really have a business program and the TA helped by providing advice and information.

- This teaching assistant supplemented seemingly theoretical problems with context and real-life circumstances, making the course material significantly easier to comprehend on the conceptual level. He not only always came to discussion prepared with a structured lesson plan but was also flexible regarding any pressing questions the students might have had, and as such was capable of managing time between both extremely well.
